The alumni committees must allocate resources and name a responsible person to make sure the building is cleaned properly after parties. The room shall be cleaned by 09.00 the next day.

Activities

UWC Connect offers activities during Friday 9th 14:00 – 17:00 and Saturday 10th 14.00-17.00. Activities are kayaking, canoeing, archery, and stand up paddleboard. Participants will have to pre-book for this on sign up list upon arrival to campus on a first comes first served basis. Other activities such as football and walks will also be good options and will be self-organized. On Friday evening 17.00-20.00 and Sunday daytime 11.00 – 17.00 the pools are open for swimming (additional charge applies and are paid directly at the Rehabilitation Centre reception).

Practicalities

UWC Red Cross Nordic campus is a smoke and alcohol free area.

An exception has been made for this occasion. Alcohol consumption is only allowed inside the Leif Høegh Centre and the Baking House, smoking at the designated area outside the Høegh. Guests and visitors to the campus are asked to respect this.

Transport

The College will organize a shuttle service from Flekke on the day of arrival and day of departure, to correspond with public transport. We encourage visitors with cars to help their friends with pick up at Førde airport/bus station.
