**The Leif Høegh Centre** and the new Baking House is available for reunion participants at the indicated times above. It is important that music is turned off at 2345 so as not to disturb residents on campus and patients at RKHR.

#### **Activities**

UWC Connect offers activities during Friday 9<sup>th</sup> 16:00 – 18:00 and Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> 14:00-17:00. Activities are climbing, kayaking, canoeing, archery, and stand up paddleboard. Participants will have to pre-book this on sign up list upon arrival on a first comes, first served basis. Self-organized activities such as football and walks will also be good options. On Friday evening 17:00-20:00 and Sunday daytime 11:00 – 17:00 the pools are open for swimming (additional charge applies and are paid directly at the Rehabilitation Centre reception).

#### **Practicalities**

UWC Red Cross Nordic campus is a smoke and alcohol free area.

An exception has been made for this occasion. Alcohol consumption is only allowed inside the Leif Høegh Centre and the Baking House, smoking at the designated area outside the Høegh. Guests and visitors to the campus are asked to respect this. Parking only in designated areas along the main road.

## Cleaning

The alumni committees must allocate resources and name a responsible person to make sure the Høegh and Baking House are cleaned properly after parties.

## **Transport**

The College will organize a shuttle service from Flekke on the day of arrival and day of departure, to correspond with public transport. We encourage visitors with cars to help their friends with pick up at Førde airport/bus station. This will be coordinated through Mostak and Year Reps. Participants who need help should communicate their needs by June  $1^{\rm st}$ .
